










## Minutes of First Meeting of IQAC No- IQAC/01/2017

  - e) The adequacy, maintenance and proper allocation of support infrastructure and services
10. It was resolved IQAC-ACPCE will perform to following functions,
- a) Setting and meeting up quality benchmarks and targets for the various academic, training , placements and administrative activities of the institutions
  - b) Broadcasting and working on fulfillment of Mission, Vision statements and incorporating various quality features for UG/PG/Diploma levels of education.
  - c) Regular conduction and setting up time table of workshops, seminars, expert talks on trending engineering themes and promotion of quality circles
  - d) Recording and maintaining complete documentation of the various programmes/activities leading to quality improvement.

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- e) Acting as the sole and supreme central quality assurance, promoting and monitoring agency of the institution.
  - f) Responsible for preparation of the Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) to be submitted to NAAC based on the quality parameters.
