Activities

1. Two days National conference on Role and Contribution of Students and Youth Movements in Nation Building During Pre and Post-Independence Era(on virtual mode)

Date of the Activity: 9th January 2022

Description of activity: The NSS Unit of ACPCE participated in the Two Days National Conference on Role and Contribution of Students and Youth Movements in Nation Building during Pre and Post-Independence Era on the auspicious occasion of Birth Anniversary of Hon'ble Prof. Bal Apte and Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav (75 years of India's Independence) was organized by University of Mumbai Prof. Bal Apte Centre for studies and Youth Movements.

The conference was highlighted on the youth and student movements across geographies, its impact and role played by the youth leaders and their visions. It would also focus on study of various youth and student movements in different era and their contribution in nation building, demographic dividends, and objectives of NER etc. 35 students attended the same.

3. Environment Conservation Webinar

Date of Activity : 24th January 2022

Description of Activity: Department of Humanity and basic Science and NSS Unit of ACPCE in association with vegan outreach organized a webinar on Environment Conservation. The session was about the importance of environmental conservation and its solution. It was an Engaging and interactive session with ACPCE NSS unit. 35 students attended the programme.

Date of Activity : 26th January 2022

Description Of Activity-: On the Occasion of 73rd Republic Day, NSS ACPCE Celebrated this Republic Day by Planting many trees. Planting a sapling/ tree is a lifelong investment. How well this investment grows depends on the type of tree selected and the planting location, the care provided during planting, and the follow-up care after planting was explained by volunteers. 6. Road Safety Webinar:-

The event started with an introduction of ppt on the topic "road safety".
