





Outcome Based Education (OBE)


- Outcome Based Education is an approach to education in which decisions about the curriculum, instruction and assessment are driven by the key learning outcomes that the students should demonstrate at the end of a program or a course.
- In a process-based education, "product defines process".
- It is the opposite of input-based education where the emphasis is on the teaching and the system is happy to accept whatever is the result.

Advantages of OBE

- Clarity: An explicit statement of what the educational process aims to achieve, clarifies the expectations for both students and teachers, and generates a focus for teaching and learning.
